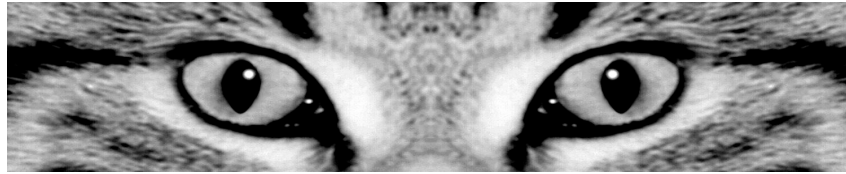

David Chown — Keyboards

David has been playing piano and keyboards in the Traverse City area since 1992. He has played at the Grand Hotel on Macinac Island, the Grand Traverse Resort, the Park Place Hotel, Traverse City Golf and Country Club, and Bay Harbor. He has four available CD's of piano music, "**Forever Love**," "**D.C. Standard time**," "**My Christmas Favorites**," and "**In a Mellow Mood**." Most recently and his first departure from the solo piano format is his fifth CD, "**On Jazz Street**." In "**On Jazz Street**," Chown returns to the music that first moved him, performing a collection of jazz classics and two new compositions, ably supported by bassist Jack Dryden and drummer Randy Marsh, a swinging trio known as the **DC3**.

Ronnie is a sensational singer who has worked extensively in the Chicago area with many top orchestras, and has done numerous jingles for television and radio. He has played at the Grand Traverse Resort, the Park Place Hotel, City Limits, and Bay Harbor. He operates his own business called Standout Productions.
